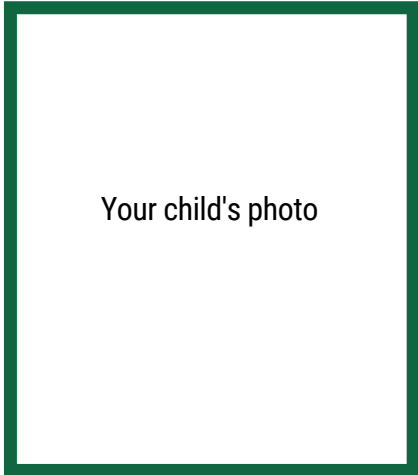


HOW TO TREAT LOW BLOOD SUGAR

1. Low blood sugar must be treated IMMEDIATELY
2. DO NOT leave a student alone if you suspect low blood sugar
3. Treat the low blood sugar WHERE IT OCCURS. Walking to a different location may cause blood sugar to drop even more.
4. Even students who are independent with their diabetes care may need assistance when their blood sugar is low.
